

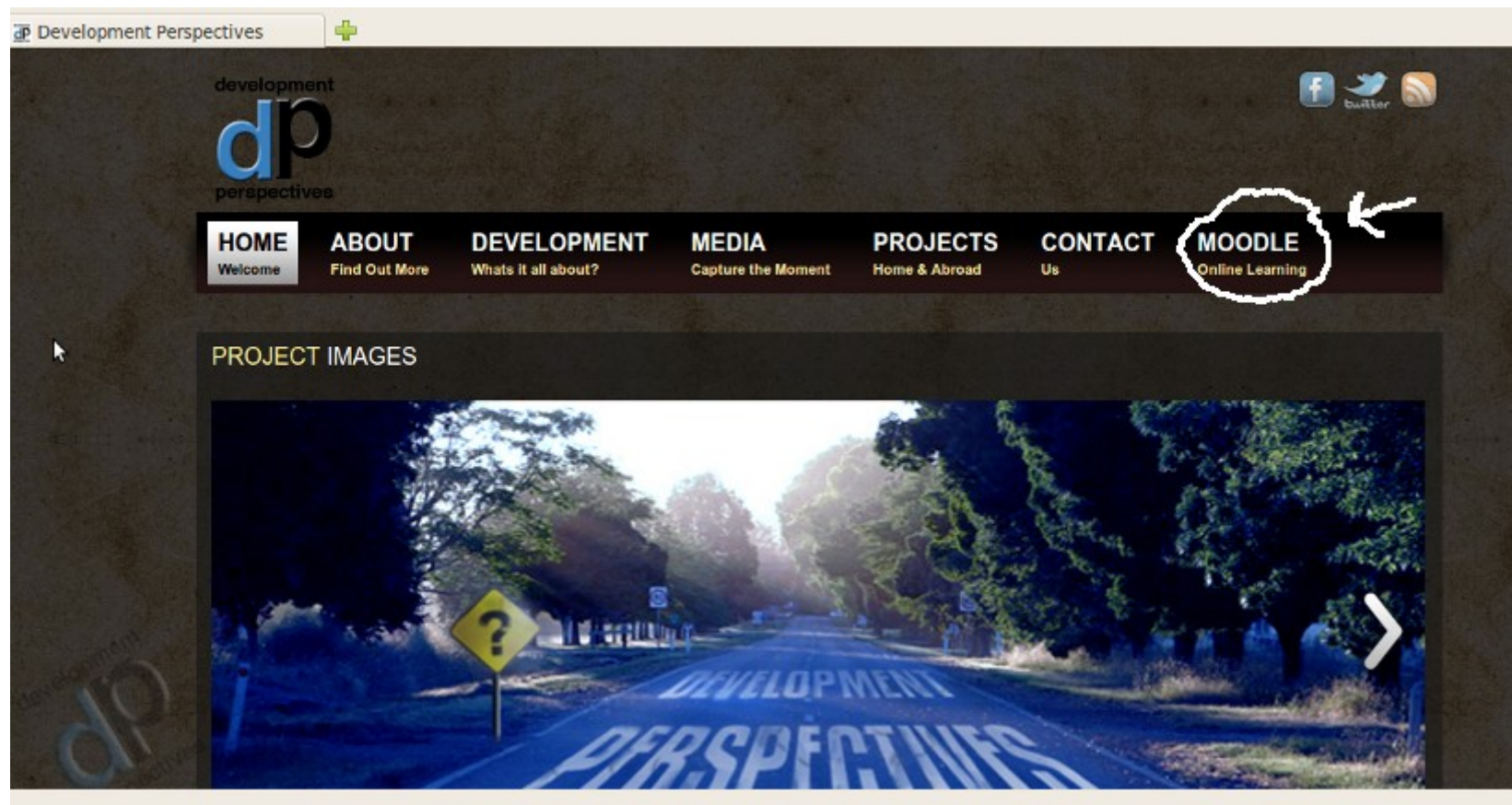
Instructions for using Development Perspective's Moodle Site.

A moodle is a Virtual Learning Environment.

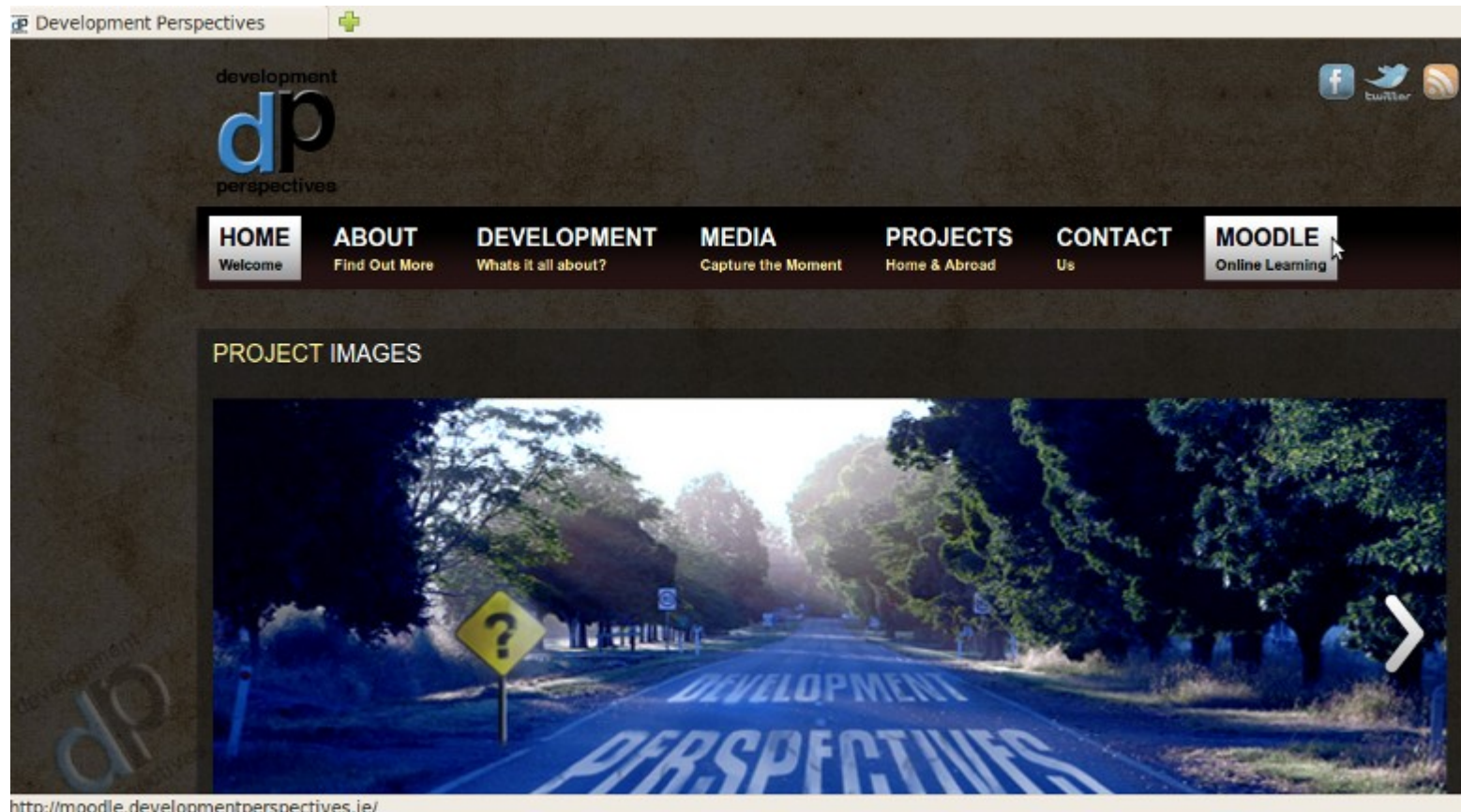
Moodle was originally developed by Martin Dougiamas to help educators create online courses with a focus on interaction and collaborative construction of content, and is in continual evolution.

To access the DP Moodle site go to www.developmentperspectives.ie and click on the moodle link on the top right of the menu bar



When you hover your mouse pointer over the Moodle button it will light up.

Click on it to go to the Moodle log in page.



The DP moodle page will look like this. The log in link is on the top right of the screen. Click where it says (Login)
